1ST AID TEAM: Qualified Leaders will be wearing white necker with green cross

If someone has suffered a medical emergency, the following procedures are to be followed:

1. In serious injury, contact JANICE SCOTT (3 whistles) who will call 911.
2. For less severe injuries, consult a 1st aider and contact the youth's Troop leader.
3. Troop leader will notify emergency contact person(s) and advises them on the incident.
4. Troop leader may request youth pick up or proceed to the **Queensway Carleton Hospital**.
5. Physical Fitness Form needs to accompany the injured party if they go to the hospital.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURES

In the event of an incident requiring evacuation (3 Horns), all participants are to move to the Emergency Evacuation Area, (Point "H" on map)

RECOGNIZING FROSTBITE

Mild frostbite makes the skin look white or waxy but the colour returns once the skin is warm again. Severe frostbite begins with white or waxy-looking skin but, as the damage progresses, the colour becomes grey or bluish. Move the person out of the cold, provide indirect heat (but not directly on the skin), and wrap the frostbitten parts in sterile bandages and try to keep them from getting banged or hurt any further.

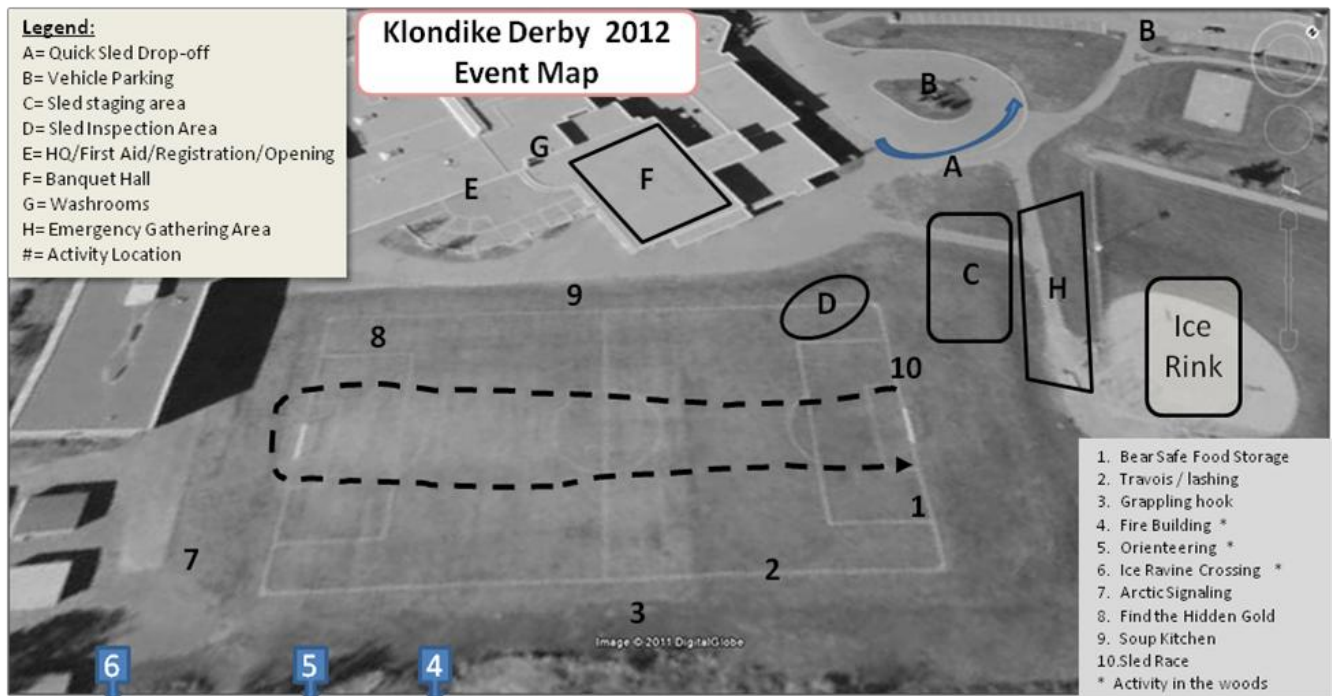
